

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF A BRIDLEWAY DIVERSION &
FOOTPATH UPGRADE TO BRIDLEWAY ORDER**

**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 SECTION 257
AND PARAGRAPH 7 OF SCHEDULE 14**

**SLAUGHTERFORD FARM, CHAPEL ROAD, BARNS GREEN
Part of BRIDLEWAY NO 1604 AND part of FOOTPATH NO 1598
DIVERSION ORDER 2010 (Number 1)**

On the 12th March 2010 Horsham District Council confirmed the above Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the public bridleway shown by a broken bold line on the map annexed to the Order and running across land at Slaughterford Farm, Chapel Road, Barns Green and to create an alternative bridleway on the land shown by a broken and dotted line on the map. The footpath shown by a starred line on the map is to be upgraded to a bridleway to link the above routes.

A copy of the confirmed Order and the Order map may be seen at the offices of Horsham District Council free of charge between 9.00 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. Monday to Thursday and between 9.00 a.m. and 4.20 p.m. on Friday. Copies of the Order and the map may be bought there at the price of £5.

The Order comes into force on the date on which Horsham District Council certifies that the terms of Article 2 of the Order have been complied with but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any Regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under Section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within six weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by Paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to the Act.
